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EZ Patch

Finished Size 45" x 60"

Note: WOF means "width of fabric." Seam allowance is $1 / 4$ " throughout. This quilt is intended as an economy quilt designed to utilize 44 " wide fabric most efficiently. If you choose to prewash fabrics, overcast raw edges to avoid loss of fabric through raveling. We use a single fold binding. Tutorial available at fabriccafe. com. If double fold binding is preferred, an additional $1 / 2$ yard of fabric is needed.

## Cutting Instructions

From Fabric \#1:

* Cut 1, 8" x WOF for Strip Assembly "B"
* Cut 1,8 " x WOF; from this strip, cut $1,8^{\prime \prime} \times 25^{\prime \prime}$ for Partial Strip Assembly "B"
* Cut 2, 8" x WOF for Strip Assembly "C"
From Fabric \#2:
* Cut 1, 8" x WOF for Strip Assembly "A"
* Cut 1,8 " x WOF; from this strip, cut $1,8^{\prime \prime} \times 17^{\prime \prime}$ for Partial Strip Assembly "A". From the remainder of this strip, cut $1,8^{\prime \prime} \times 9^{\prime \prime}$ for Partial Strip Assembly "A"
* Cut 2, 8" x WOF for Strip Assembly "C"
From Fabric \#3:
* Cut 1, 8" x WOF for Strip Assembly "B"
* Cut 1,8 " x WOF; from this strip, cut $1,8^{\prime \prime} \times 25^{\prime \prime}$ for Partial Strip Assembly "B". From the remainder of this strip, cut $1,8^{\prime \prime} \times 17^{\prime \prime}$ for Partial Strip Assembly "A"
* Cut 1, 8" x WOF for Strip Assembly "A"
* Cut 1,8 " x WOF; from this strip, cut 1, 8" x 9" for Partial Strip Assembly "A". From the remainder of this strip, cut 6, 11/4" x 33" Binding Extensions * Cut $1,1 \frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF for binding


## From Backing Fabric:

* Cut 2, 54" x WOF

Step 1: Unit "A", "B" and "C" Assembly
Referring to Strip Assembly "A" diagram, using one fabric \#2, 8 " x WOF strip and one fabric \#3, 8" x WOF strip, sew together on long edges. Repeat using Partial Strip Assembly strips, making one full and 2 partial assemblies. Cut into 8,8 " x $151 / 2$ " Unit "A". Referring to Strip Assembly "B" diagram, using one fabric \#1, $8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip and one fabric \#3, 8" x WOF strip, sew together on long edges. Repeat using Partial Strip Assembly strips, making one full and one partial assemblies. Cut into 8,8 " x $151 / 2$ " Unit "B". Referring to Strip Assembly "C" diagram, using one fabric \#1, 8 " x WOF strip and one fabric \#2, 8" x WOF strip, sew together on long edges. Repeat making 2 assemblies. Cut into 8,8 " x $151 / 2$ " Unit " $C$ ".

## Step 2: Block "A", "B" \& "C" Assembly <br> Referring to Block "A"

Assembly diagram, using one Unit "A" and one Unit "B", sew together as shown. Repeat making 4, $15^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 151 / 2$ " Block "A". Referring to Block "B" Assembly diagram, using one Unit "C" and one Unit "A", sew together as shown. Repeat making $4,151 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 151 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Block "B". Referring to Block "C" Assembly diagram, using one Unit "B" and one Unit "C", sew together as shown. Repeat making 4, 151/2" x 15½" Block "C".

## Step 3: Quilt Assembly Referring to Quilt Assembly diagram, alternating Blocks


"A", "B" and "C" as shown, assemble 4 rows of 3 blocks each.

## Step 4: Backing \& Binding

Sew backing fabric together along trimmed selvage edges; press. Layer top, batting and backing together; quilt as desired. For binding, using fabric \#3, $11 / 4$ " $\times$ WOF binding strips and Binding Extensions, sew strips together end to end. Press

in half with wrong sides together; press one raw edge to center fold. Place right side of binding to front side of quilt. Using a scant $1 / 4 "$, sew unpressed edge of binding to quilt, mitering corners. Fold to back and hand stitch in place.

Strip Assembly "A"


Make one full and 2 partial assemblies.
Cut 8,8 " $\times 151 / 2$ " Unit "A"
Make 4, $151 / 2$ " $\times 151 / 2$ " Block "A"

Block "B" Assembly


Make 4, $151 / 2$ " $\times 151 / 2$ " Block "B"
Cut 8,8 " $\times 151 / 2$ " Unit "B"


Make 2 assemblies. Cut 8,8 " $\times 151 / 2$ " Unit "C"

Make 4, $15 ½$ " x 15½" Block "C"
