

# Preparing Backing Fabric for a Queen/King-Size Quilt

A Free Goodie from Fabric Cafe®



**Materials:** 9 yards of 44" wide fabric

## **Step 1: Preparing Fabric**

Cut 9 yards of fabric into 3, 3 yard pieces. Trim off selvage edges making 3, 42" x 108" backing pieces.

## **Step 2: Assemble Backing**

Referring to **Backing Assembly** diagram, with right sides together and using  $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance, sew trimmed selvage edges together making one 108" x 126" backing.

*Note: Due to variable widths of fabric, the finished measurement will not be an exact width measurement.*

## **Step 3: Position Backing**

Turn backing so that the width is 126" and the length is 108". This will be plenty of fabric to back any one of the Fabric Cafe Queen/King-Size quilts.
