

# Make A Quilt Hanging Sleeve

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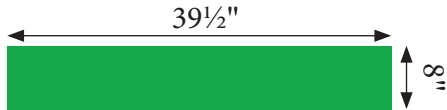
## Step 1: Measure

Measure the top edge of finished quilt.



## Step 2: Cut Sleeve

Subtract 1" from top edge measurement. Cut 1 piece of coordinating fabric that is this measurement x 8".



## Step 3: Finish Ends

Press one short edge under 1/4". Press same edge under an additional 1/4"; topstitch in place. Repeat on opposite end.

Press one short edge under 1/4".  
Press same edge under an additional 1/4"



## Step 4: Assemble Sleeve

Fold sleeve in half with wrong sides together, matching raw edges; sew. Press hanging sleeve flat and seam allowances open, positioning the seam in the center.

Matching raw edges, sew



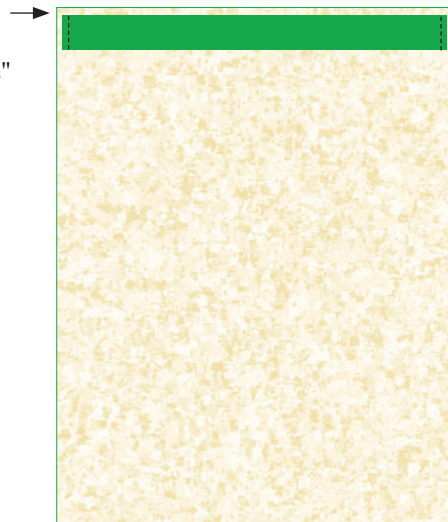
Press flat with seam in center



## Step 5: Stitch to Quilt

With sleeve seam against back of quilt, pin top edge of sleeve to back of quilt, 1/2" from top edge; hand stitch in place. Pin bottom edge of sleeve to back of quilt; hand stitch in place.

Hand stitch sleeve 1/2" from top edge



Hand stitch bottom edge in place
