Easy-to-Follow Instructions

Referring to **Step 3** diagram, using one fabric #3, 2½" x WOF strip, sew to top of one **Step 2**; trim even with sides. Repeat on bottom. Repeat making 6, 9" x 13" **Step 3**.

Referring to **Step 4** diagram, using one fabric #3, 2½" x WOF strip, sew to side of **Step 3**; trim even with top and bottom. Repeat on second side. Repeat making 6, 13" x 13" **Block "B"**.

Step 3: Quilt Assembly

Referring to **Quilt Assembly** diagram, alternating **Blocks "A"** and **"B"** as shown, assemble 4 rows of 3 blocks each.

Step 4: Borders

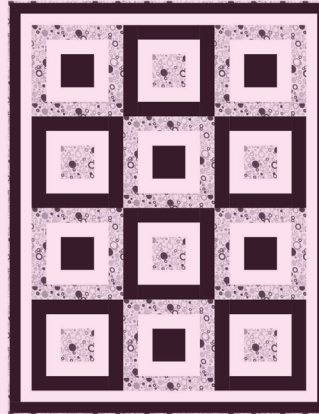
For border #1, using fabric #2, 2" x WOF border strips, sew together end to end. Sew strip to each side of quilt; trim even with top and bottom. Using remainder of strip, sew to top and bottom; trim even with sides. For border #2, repeat using fabric #3, 2" x WOF border strips.

Twin Topper

Finished Size: 60" x 85"

Materials: 2 yards each of 3 fabrics
Cutting Instructions: Referring to Cutting Instructions on page 8, **for blocks only**, cut 2 times the number of pieces stated. **Make 2 times the number of blocks stated.**

For borders & binding, cut as follows:

Border #1: from fabric #2, cut 7, 3" x WOF

Border #2: from fabric #3, cut 8, 3" x WOF

Binding: from fabric #1, cut 8, 1½" x WOF

Assemble 6 rows of 4 blocks each



Twin Topper Enlargement Diagram

Queen/King Topper

Finished Size: 101½" x 89"

Materials: 4 yards each of 3 fabrics

Cutting Instructions: Referring to Cutting Instructions on page 8, **for blocks only**, cut 4 times the number of pieces stated. **Make 21 Block "A" and 21 Block "B"**.

For borders & binding, cut as follows:

Border #1: from fabric #2, cut 9, 4" x WOF

Border #2: from fabric #3, cut 10, 4" x WOF

Binding: from fabric #1, cut 10, 1½" x WOF

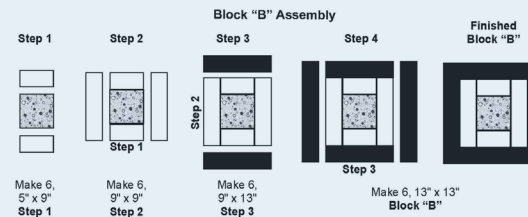
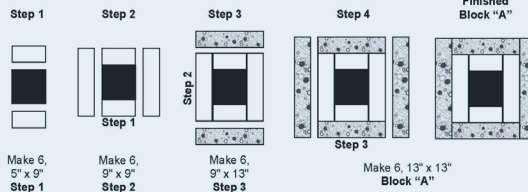

Referring to Unit "B" Assembly diagram, using 2 HST-2 Blocks, sew together as shown. Repeat making 12, 4½" x 8½" Unit "B".

Step 3: Block "A" Assembly

Referring to Block "A" Assembly, Step 1 diagram, using one Unit "A" and one Unit "B", sew together as shown. Repeat making 12, 8½" x 8½" Step 1.

Referring to Step 2 diagram, using one fabric #1, 1½" x WOF strip, sew to bottom of Step 1 as shown; trim even with sides. Repeat making 12, 8½" x 9½" Step 2.

Referring to Step 3 diagram, using one fabric #1, 1½" x WOF strip, sew to side of Step 2 as shown; trim even with top and bottom. Repeat making 12, 9½" x 9½" Block "A".

Step 4: Quilt Assembly

Referring to Quilt Assembly diagram, alternating HST-1 and "A" Blocks as shown, assemble 6 rows of 4 blocks each.

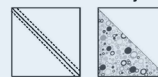
Step 5: Border

For border, using fabric #3, 2½" x WOF border strips, sew together end to end. Sew strip to each side of quilt; trim even with top and bottom. Using remainder of strip, sew to top and bottom; trim even with sides.

HST-1 Assembly



Draw line from corner to corner. Sew a scant ¼" on each side of line. Cut on drawn line. Make 12, 9½" x 9½" HST-1 Block

HST-2 Assembly



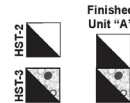
Draw line from corner to corner. Sew a scant ¼" on each side of line. Cut on drawn line. Make 36, 4½" x 4½" HST-2 Blocks

HST-3 Assembly



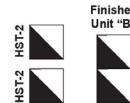
Draw line from corner to corner. Sew a scant ¼" on each side of line. Cut on drawn line. Make 12, 4½" x 4½" HST-3 Blocks

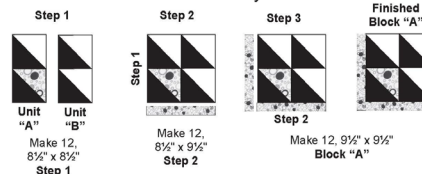

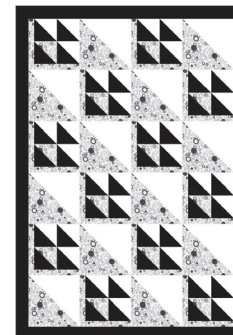

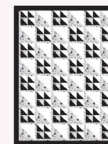

Finished Size: 59" x 77"
Materials: 2 yards each of 3 fabrics

Cutting Instructions: Referring to Cutting Instructions on page 22, for blocks only, cut 2 times the number of pieces stated. **Make 2 times the number of blocks stated.**



Twin Topper Enlargement Diagram

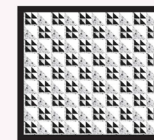
For border & binding, cut as follows:

Border: from fabric #3, cut 7, 3" x WOF
Binding: from fabric #3, cut 7, 1½" x WOF
Assemble 8 rows of 6 blocks each

Queen/King Topper

Finished Size: 99" x 90"
Materials: 4 yards each of 3 fabrics

Cutting Instructions: Referring to Cutting Instructions on page 22, for blocks only, cut 4 times the number of pieces stated. **Make 45 Block "A" and 45 Block "B".**



Queen/King Topper Enlargement Diagram

For border & binding, cut as follows:

Border: from fabric #3, cut 9, 5" x WOF
Binding: from fabric #3, cut 10, 1½" x WOF
Assemble 9 rows of 10 blocks each

Enlarging Reflections

Twin Topper

Finished Size: 64" x 83"

Materials: 2 yards each of 3 fabrics

Cutting Instructions: Referring to Cutting Instructions on page 18, for blocks only, cut 2 times the number of pieces stated. **Make 2 times the number of blocks stated.**

For border & binding, cut as follows:

Border: from fabric #2, cut 7, 4" x WOF

Binding: from fabric #2, cut 8, 1 1/4" x WOF

Assemble 8 rows of 6 blocks each

Finished Size: 104" x 94 1/2"

Materials: 4 yards each of 3 fabrics

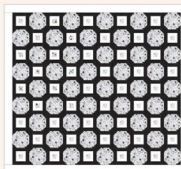
Cutting Instructions: Referring to Cutting Instructions on page 18, for blocks only, cut 4 times the number of pieces stated. **Make 45 Block "A" and 45 Block "B".**

For border & binding, cut as follows:

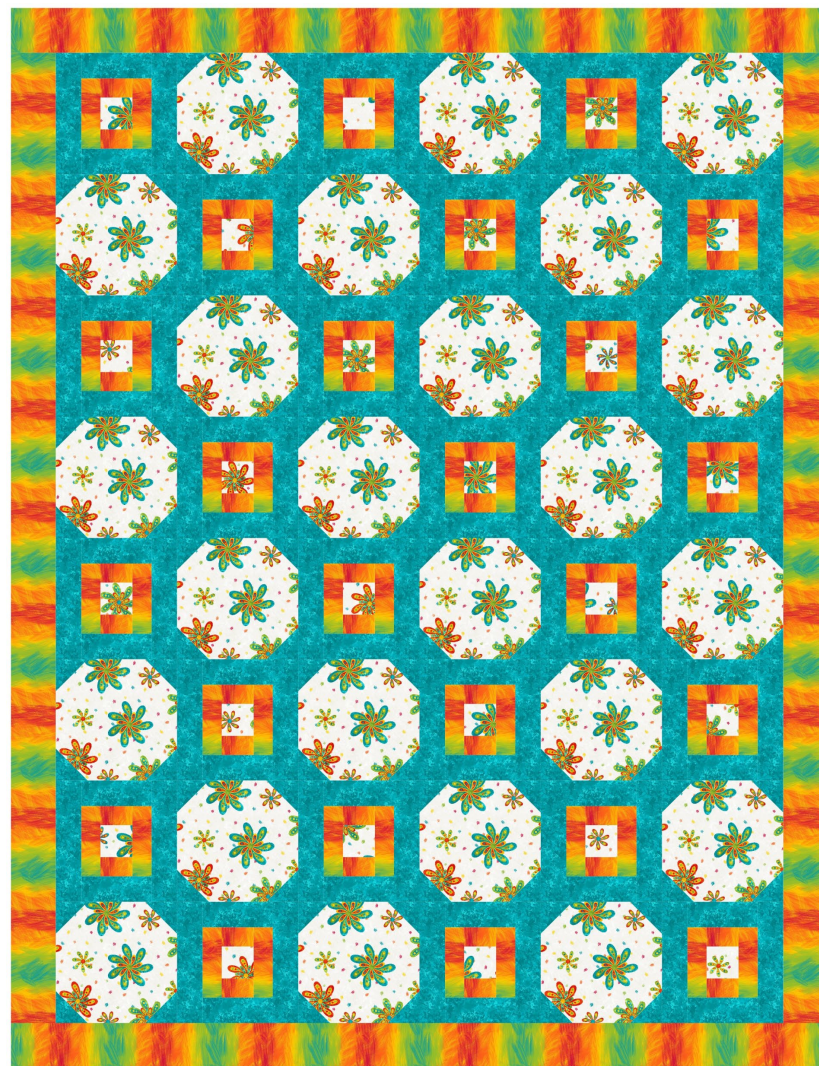
Border: from fabric #2, cut 10, 5" x WOF

Binding: from fabric #2, cut 11, 1 1/4" x WOF

Assemble 9 rows of 10 blocks each

What You Want: Clear Instructions

Veranda

Notes: Before you begin cutting, read general information, material requirements and special instructions for enlarging the quilt on pages 2 & 3. Refer to **Fabric Selection Guide** on page 23 to select fabric positions. WOF means "width of fabric." **Half Square Triangle** has been abbreviated to **HST**. Seam allowance is $\frac{1}{4}$ " throughout.

This quilt can be made with three, one-yard cuts of fabric. If you see one of the following symbols, a precut can be substituted.

Cutting Instructions





From Fabric #1:

-  Cut 2, 10" x WOF; from these strips, cut 6, 10" x 10" squares for **HST-1 Assembly**
-  Cut 1, 5" x WOF; from this strip, cut 6, 5" x 5" squares for **HST-3 Assembly**
-  Cut 6, 1½" x WOF for **Block "A" Assembly**


From Fabric #2:

-  Cut 1, 10" x WOF; from this strip, cut 4, 10" x 10" squares for **HST-1 Assembly**
-   Cut 1, 10" x WOF; from this strip, cut 2, 10" x 10" squares for **HST-1 Assembly**. From the remainder of this strip, cut 2, 5" x 5" squares for **HST-2 Assembly**
-  Cut 2, 5" x WOF; from these strips, cut 16, 5" x 5" squares for **HST-2 Assembly**

From Fabric #3:

-  Cut 2, 5" x WOF; from these strips, cut 16, 5" x 5" squares for **HST-2 Assembly**
-  Cut 1, 5" x WOF; from this strip, cut 2, 5" x 5" squares for **HST-2 Assembly** and 6, 5" x 5" squares for **HST-3 Assembly**
-  Cut 5, 2½" x WOF for border
-  Cut 5, 1¼" x WOF for binding

From Backing Fabric:

-  Cut 2, 54" x WOF

Step 1: HST-1, HST-2 & HST-3 Assembly

Referring to **HST-1 Assembly** diagram, using a fabric marking pen, draw a line diagonally from corner to corner on wrong side of 6 fabric #2, 10" x 10" squares. Using one each of fabric #1 and #2,

Using precuts will make this quilt a breeze to complete



Finished Size: 40" x 58"



10" x 10" squares for each **HST-1 Assembly**, place right sides together. Sew a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of line. Cut on drawn line; press blocks open. Trim and square blocks to 9½" x 9½". Repeat making 12, 9½" x 9½" **HST-1 Blocks**.

Referring to **HST-2 Assembly** diagram, repeat using 18 fabric #2, 5" x 5" squares and 18 fabric #3, 5" x 5" squares, making 36, 4½" x 4½" **HST-2 Blocks**.

Referring to **HST-3 Assembly** diagram, repeat using 6 fabric #1, 5" x 5" squares and 6 fabric #3, 5" x 5" squares, making 12, 4½" x 4½" **HST-3 Blocks**.

Step 2: Unit "A" & "B" Assembly

Referring to Unit "A" Assembly diagram, using one **HST-2 Block** and one **HST-3 Block**, sew together as shown. Repeat making 12, 4½" x 8½" Unit "A".
