# Embroidery Stitches A Free Goodie from Fabric Café



Thread

Transferred Stitch Line

Transferred Stitch Dot

### **Back Stitch**



Insert needle and pull to right side of fabric on the transferred stitch line.

#### Step 2


Following transferred stitch line, insert needle approximately 1/8" from Step 1 and pull to the wrong side.

### Step 3

Following transferred stitch line, insert and pull needle to the right side of fabric 1/8" from Step 1.

Repeat Steps 1-3 until desired line is stitched.

### Stem Stitch



### Step 1

Insert needle above transferred stitch line and pull to right side of fabric.

### Step 2


Insert needle on opposite side of transferred stitch line 45 degrees from **Step 1** and pull to wrong side.

### Step 3

Insert needle to the right side of Step 1 and pull to the right side of fabric. Stitches should be close to each other, but not splitting the thread.

Repeat Steps 2 and 3 until desired line is stitched.

# French Knot



### Step 1

Insert needle to the right of transferred stitch dot and pull to right side of fabric.


### Step 2

Point the needle away from the fabric and wrap the floss around the needle twice.

### Step 3

Holding the thread firmly, turn the needle towards the fabric and insert to the left side of transferred stitch dot. Holding the wrapped thread against the surface of the fabric, pull the needle to the wrong side.

# Lazy Daisy Stitch





### Step 1

Insert needle to the right side of transferred stitch line point and pull to right side of fabric.

### Step 2

Insert needle to the left side of transferred stitch line point, pull to wrong side leaving a generous loop of thread.

### Step 3

Insert needle at the center top of transerred stitch line, catching loop of thread from Step 2.

Insert needle directly above Step 3 securing loop of thread, pull to wrong side of fabric.
